

INTER COMMERCIAL HOUSE COMPETITION

JUDGING CRITERIA

LYRICS (40 POINTS)

WORD CRAFT (15 Points)

- Appropriateness of choice of words
- Use of satire, subtlety, double entendre, irony, wit, humor, puns, play on words
- Quality of rhyme

COMPOSITION (15 Points)

- Marriage of lyrics & melody (synchronized development of lyrics melody)
- Do the words compliment each other smoothly & comfortably?
- Is the song over crowded; with the singer having to rush the words to get them in?
- How smoothly do the lyrics flow along with the arrangement?

CREATIVITY (5 Points)

 Unusually interesting interpretation of the topic or the effective incorporation of local colour or experience into the song.

THEME EXPRESSION/CONTENT (Quality) (5 Points)

- Does the song have a distinct recognizable theme?
- How well do the words develop & support the theme?
- Do the verses flow or develop with the chorus to reinforce the theme & meaning of the song?



MUSIC (30 POINTS)

MELODY (15 Points)

- Strength & melodious appeal of the song, melody of the verses sung, chorus & band chorus.
- Does the tune carry the message effectively? Is it married to the lyric in terms of its meter?
- Does it capture the mood of the theme?

ARRANGEMENT (10 Points)

- Does it suit the mood & tempo?
- Are particular instruments/sounds used to specially create & convey mood?
- Does the arrangement compliment the rendition?
- Do the back-up vocals compliment & enhance the arrangement?

ORIGINALITY (5 Points)

- Are the melody & arrangement original?
- Are pieces of other people's ideas in the arrangement or melody?
- Is there any successful incorporation of unusual musical instruments or combination of instruments?

PERFORMANCE (30 POINTS)

RENDITION (15Points)

- Does the singer use his/her voice to effectively interpret the song?
- Is the singer in the proper key?
- Is the manner of singing in keeping with the mood of the song?
- Is the diction clear & understandable?

PRESENTATION (10 Points)

- The use of body body language, hands, facial expression and use of dress.
- The use of the stage.
- The Use of the microphone.
- Are these being used to more effectively communicate the song and to improve the understanding of its lyrics?

DEMONSTRATION (5 Points)



- This includes the use of props, stagehands and dancers.
- Are these other symbols of communication assisting or interfering with the presentation of the song?
- Are they original symbols?
