

SWIMWEAR (20 Points)

Time Limit: 90 seconds

1. **Muscle Tone** (4 points)
Contestants' muscles should appear firm and toned.
2. **Poise & Carriage** (7 points)
Evaluation of how well the contestant carries herself, including confidence and grace.
3. **Figure/Proportion** (4 points)
The balance and proportion of bust, waist, and hips, ensuring a natural and flattering ratio.
4. **Design & Fit** (5 points)
Assessment of the material, finish, and fit of the swimwear. The relationship between the contestant's body and the swimwear should be visually appealing and exciting.

PERFORMING TALENT (30 Points)

Time Limit: 4 minutes

1. **Authenticity/Originality (10 points)**
The performance should authentically represent the assigned theme while highlighting the originality of the contestant's talent and creativity.
2. **Artistic Merit/Execution (10 points)**
Evaluation of the artistic elements of the performance, including choreography, musicality, emotional expression, and interpretation.
3. **Presentation/Impact (5 points)**
The use of props, costumes, and accompaniment should complement the performance without overpowering it.
4. **Scenography (5 points)**
The effective use of space, accessories, costumes, lighting, and timing to enhance the performance

EVENING WEAR (25 Points)

Time Limit: 2 minutes

1. **Impact** (5 points)
The ability of the contestant's appearance and presentation to evoke appreciation and admiration.
2. **Poise/Fluidity/Department** (10 points)
The contestant's ability to walk gracefully across the stage, executing turns smoothly, and maintaining elegant posture.
3. **Design & Fit** (10 points)
The design should reflect the theme, with careful attention to material, finish, and fit. The relationship between the contestant's body and the evening wear should be visually striking and exciting.



FIRST INTERVIEW (20 Points)

Time Limit: 45 seconds

1. Content/Relevance (7 points)

The accuracy and appropriateness of the contestant's response in relation to the question. The answer is insightful, well-structured, and addresses all aspects of the question directly.

2. Clarity/Fluency (5 points)

Speech flows naturally and effortlessly, with no noticeable pauses or hesitations. The response is clear and easy to understand, demonstrating strong command of language.

3. Delivery/Confidence (3 points)

The contestant maintains strong, consistent eye contact with both judges and the audience. Natural and purposeful gestures are used to enhance the message without being excessive. The contestant appears confident and in control, delivering the answer with conviction and ease.

4. Diction (5 points)

Proper pronunciation is used, with clear articulation of words and correct emphasis on syllables. The contestant demonstrates confidence in selecting words that reflect intelligence and eloquence.

COSTUME (25 Points)

Time Limit: 3 minutes

1. Enhancement & Craftsmanship (5 points)

Assessment of how effectively the original Carnival band costume has been enhanced, including quality of construction, detailing, finish, and the seamless integration of new design elements.

2. Creativity & Transformation (5 points)

The originality and innovation applied in transforming the selected band costume, and how well the enhancements elevate the overall concept into a unique and compelling presentation.

3. Impact & Stage Presentation (10 points)

The contestant's ability to bring the costume to life on stage, creating a strong visual and emotional impact while commanding audience attention.

4. Wearability & Mobility (5 points)

The contestant's ease, confidence, and fluidity in carrying the costume, including how well it supports movement, balance, and effective use of the stage space.

SECOND INTERVIEW (20 Points)

Time Limit: 45 seconds

5. Content/Relevance (7 points)

The accuracy and appropriateness of the contestant's response in relation to the question. The answer is insightful, well-structured, and addresses all aspects of the question directly.

6. Clarity/Fluency (5 points)
